

BLENDED

HCHC helps families raise healthy, curious and happy children. Join us for Organic Farming each year and get 8-weeks of fun, hands-on learning in Earth & Animal Science. Excellent for tactile and kinesthetic learners!

Your child will enjoy hands-on lessons and outdoor fun at a local, organic farm, with a weekly curriculum, and guidance to build your very own backyard garden. 1x week, 90-minutes. Masks required*

More than ever homeschool families with young kids, realize the importance of spending purposeful time outside. Studies show that children need outdoor play to experience valuable social interactions that can't be gained from spending time in front of a screen.

Spending time out on the farm gives families an opportunity to make purposeful outdoor play achievable rain or shine.



PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Parents are expected to actively participate at Day School a minimum of 2 weeks out of a 12-week term and 1 week out of an 8-week term. Parents may elect to pay a \$50.00 **Opt-Out Fee** if they're unable to volunteer their time to the co-op.

Together as a community, we create a safe and welcoming environment for students to learn, socialize, and explore. Parents are free to learn alongside their child, remain on campus and tele-work, or drop-off.

Parents are expected to be available for their children in times of need and/or emergency. Those who elect to drop-off are subject to signing a Liability Waiver, must remain within a 20-mile radius of campus and are charged a \$15 **DROP-OFF Fee** per occurrence.

OUR PEDAGOGY & PHILOSOPHY

Like many classical-type homeschooling programs, HCHC stresses memorization of basic facts—geography, history, science and math—throughout the early years, which is easily accomplished through play and song. Writing skills are introduced as early as third grade, and Latin is made available when in demand. Throughout the middle and high school years, facts and the study of classic literature are used as a foundation upon lessons in rhetoric and logic, plus formal writing and research. Once or twice a week, students meetup at our brick n' mortar facility—located in Columbia, MD – for Day School. Children break into age-appropriate learning pods, each led by a certified tutor or qualified parent teacher, where they recount lessons of the previous week and learn new concepts to be studied at home. During the remainder of the week, parents are expected to take full responsibility for their child's home education program and instruction.

AFFORDABLE PAYMENT PLANS

Each family pays tuition for each child to cover facility maintenance, instructional supplies, and tutor costs. Although resource materials are made available via HCHC's Teachers Pay Teachers (TpT) website, families purchase the curriculum of their choice. We offer a 12-week fall semester, two 8-week terms during the spring semester, and an 8week summer program. Classes meet 1x or 2x a week for 60-minutes, with few exceptions.

HCHC Leadership Academy is a *private homeschool tutorial* – a cross between private school and co-op. By Maryland state law, certified tutors are not allowed to provide homeschooled children with "thorough instruction." According to the COMAR, that is the responsibility of the parents. Therefore, HCHC tutors guide students through the week's course material. Parents take this information and use it however they see fit throughout their homeschool week. Some use it as a supplement while others use it as the base of their core homeschool curriculum. It's very flexible.
