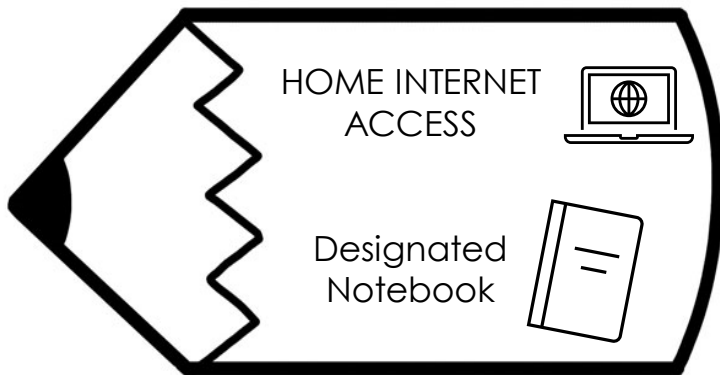

CURRICULUM

This beginner course focuses on:

1. speaking the language and mastering how it sounds, and
2. writing/learning Hiragana., one of 3 sets of Japanese characters.

STUDENT GOALS

The goal of this course is to develop the basic skill of speaking, the most important element in learning any language.

At the end of this course, students should be able to demonstrate the ability to carry on basic daily conversations, including greeting and self-introduction. In addition to speaking, students are expected to recognize and demonstrate writing Hiragana.
