Howard County Home-Educator Corp. | 529 Plan Information

Families may be able to use 529 plan funds toward qualified K-12 tuition expenses. Federal tax law permits up to \$10,000 per year, per student, for K-12 tuition, though families should always confirm eligibility and distribution requirements with their plan administrator or tax professional.

What parents should know

- 529 distributions for K-12 are generally limited to **tuition** expenses, up to \$10,000 annually per student.
- Your plan administrator may ask for the school name, mailing address, and federal EIN when processing a distribution.
- Processing times vary by plan, so families should request funds early if payment deadlines are approaching.
- Because plan rules and tax treatment can vary, families should verify the exact process with their 529 plan administrator.
